The NZRA declined to run a match for F Standard, but matches will go ahead for F/TR and F Open. Rod Mahon has been appointed Captain of the F/TR Team and there being no other nominations, Bob Pedersen will Captain the F Open Team.

NOMINATIONS ARE NOW CALLED FOR SHOOTERS/MANAGERS AND COACHES FOR BOTH F/TR AND F OPEN TEAMS TO COMPETE AS PER THE PROGRAM BELOW.

<u>Sunday 11th January</u> - Practice Day

Practice will be held in conjunction with the Wellington Prize Meeting program. The Wellington Prize meet shoots at 300/600/800/900 yds. We will practice at 800/900 yds and also at 1000yds after the Prize meeting is finished.

<u>Monday 12th January – Match Day</u>

There will be 2 Teams Matches. They will be held in conjunction with Target Rifle teams matches being held on the day.

TEAM CONDITIONS

Both F/TR and F Open Teams will shoot as separate discipline and separate teams.

Shooting teams are to consist of 5 shooters.

Teams may consist of a minimum of 5 Members and a maximum of 8 Members.

The 8 members may consist of 6 shooting members, Captain and Coach. All members may fill any of the positions in the team. A Manager may be appointed who may be one of 8 team members or a separate person.

Different members may be chosen for either of the Teams matches.
