Interstate F Class Teams Matches

Proposal to Change the Format of These Matches

At the last AGM of the NRAA on November 2015 a proposal was put forward to change the format of the Interstate F Class Teams matches. This would include all F Class Disciplines of F Open, F Standard and FTR.

Any changes to the present format would occur at the next F Class Interstate Teams matches which are scheduled to be held in South Australia in 2017 in conjunction with the SA Queens.

I have written to all States and asking them to consider and respond to these proposals by the **end of June 2016**. Each State is asked to consult widely with their F Class Shooters in reaching this decision. This notice will also be posted on the NRAA website.

There are 3 Options for consideration.

OPTION 1 – A TWO (2) Day Competition

Day 1 Practice at 800yds, 900yds and 1000yds

Followed by the first Match of 2 convertible Sighters and 20 Shots at 1000yds.

Day 2 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots at 800yds, 900yds and 1000yds

Followed by a Presentation dinner on that evening.

OPTION 2 – A THREE (3) Day Competition

Day 1 Practice at 800yds, 900yds, and 1000yds.

Followed by the first Match of 2 convertible Sighters and 20 Shots at 1000yds.

Day 2 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots at 800yds, 900yds and 1000yds.

Day 3 2 convertible sighters and 15 shots at 800yds, 900yds and 1000yds

Followed by a Presentation dinner on that evening.

OPTION 3 – Leave as is

Day 1 Practice at 300,600,900 and 1000yds.

Followed by the first Match of 2 sighters and 15 shots at 1000yds.

Day 2 2 convertible sighters and 10 shots at 300,600, 900 and 1000yds.

Followed by a Presentation Dinner on that evening.
